Chapter I

Article 1 – Definition

- 1 For the purposes of this Convention, the term "migrant worker" shall mean a person who has been recruited by a contract or other arrangement to work in an employment relationship in a country other than his country of origin or habitual residence.
- 2 The Convention shall apply to:

- f. the number of migrant workers employed in transport;
- g. the number of migrant workers employed in other sectors;
- h. the number of migrant workers employed in other sectors.

The Commission shall report to the Council on the basis of the information received.

The Council shall decide on the basis of the report of the Commission and on the basis of the information received from the Member States.
